

WHAT WE ARE DOING TO KEEP YOU SAFE:

- Limiting visitor numbers (maximum of 95, subject to change without notice).
- Encouraging online ticket sales.
- Timed-ticket admission to allow for capacity control.
- Limiting the capacity of our elevators to six persons or one cohort.
- Offering a single direction visitor experience guided by floor arrows.
- Encouraging physical distancing using floor arrows and route markers.
- Providing guests and staff with hand sanitizer stations throughout the facility.
- Providing plexi-glass barriers at our customer service areas.
- Increasing cleaning and disinfecting throughout our facility.
- Eliminating our multimedia tour guide devices and migrating the tour to an online platform for use on your phone or tablet.

WHAT WE ARE ASKING OF OUR GUESTS:

- Per City bylaw, proof of vaccination or negative Covid-19 test results (within the last 72 hours) are required to enter the facility.
- Non-medical masks or face coverings are required at all times per Government of Alberta health regulations.
- Stay at home if you are not feeling well.
- Purchase your tickets online before visiting the Calgary Tower. If you arrive without a pre-purchased ticket and we have already reached capacity, you will need to purchase a ticket for a later time slot.
- Explore the Observation Deck by following the marked route.
- Wash your hands, for at least 20 seconds, regularly during your visit. Avoid touching your face, and cover coughs or sneezes with a tissue or your elbow.
- Keep your family unit together when walking through the facilities and keep children within reach at all times.
- Please be patient with other guests. Practice physical distancing, keep two metres away from others, and wait your turn.
- Please do not bring outside food or beverages.

Our goal is to make your visit to the Calgary Tower comfortable and safe. We hope you will enjoy being back at the Tower to explore the city's history and enjoy the unforgettable view.
